## Southwest Horse Sale Fees, Terms & Conditions

## Consignment and Sale Fees:

\*The following fees apply to all animals sold or unsold on sale day. Consignment Fee is \$150. Commission is 10% of sale price. State mandated insurance fee is \$.50 per \$100 of horse value. Yardage fee \$40 per horse. No "No Sale Fee".

## Terms and Conditions:

- Consignment Forms must be accompanied by the Consignment Fee and original registration papers. Seller is responsible for having a coggins test performed and present a current negative coggins test on sale day.
- Mares selling in foal must have a completed and signed breeder's certificate or a letter from the stallion owner stating the breeder's certificate will be issued at foaling.
- Southwest Horse Sale and its affiliates are merely acting as auctioneer as to all sales or potential sales and are not responsible for any error, misunderstanding, misrepresentation, rejection or any particular sale, failure to pay as bid, condition of the horse or any other basis for dispute between the Buyer and Seller/Consignor/Owner.
- The Seller/Consignor/Owner of the horse must disclose fully any defects or bad habits and these must be called when the horse is in the sales arena and/or sold. Southwest Horse Sale and its affiliates shall not be responsible for loss or damage to horses, equipment or persons from injury, accident, fire, theft etc. in any manner, before, during, or after sale. "WARNING UNDER LOUISIANA LAW: AN EQUINE ACTIVITY SPONSOR OR EQUINE PROFESSIONAL IS NOT LIABLE FOR AN INJURY TO OR THE DEATH OF A PARTICIPANT IN EQUINE ACTIVITIES RESULTING FROM THE INHERENT RISKS OF EQUINE ACTIVITIES, PURSUANT TC R.S. 9:2795.1."
- Upon execution of this contract, Seller/Consignor/Owner agrees not to dispose of the horse by private sale. If the Seller/Consignor/Owner breaks this contract and sells the horse, Southwest Horse Sale is owed the 10% commission on the sale price and the consignment fee.
- Once the horse is consigned, he is expected to be in the ring at the time his number is called. If consigned horse is a "no show", owner agrees to pay \$500 fee in order to receive registration papers. If "grade" horse owner is liable for the \$500 due immediately following the last entry in the sale.
- Only horses consigned to the sale will be allowed on the sale grounds. All horses sold before, during and after the sale will be subject to the 10% commission fee in addition to the consignment fee. All consignments must go through the sale ring.
- The consignment fee is NON-REFUNDABLE. Horses withdrawn from the sale for any other reason besides death or extreme illness or injury are subject to the \$500 "no show" fee.
